1. Collection and Processing of Data

Any access to our website and any retrieval of a file stored on our website are logged. This logging serves internal system-related and statistical purposes. The following data is logged:

Your web browser, name of the requested file, date and time of the request, and the volume of data that has been transferred. Personal data will be recorded only when you provide this information voluntarily, for instance in connection with an enquiry.

2. Use and Disclosure of Personal Data

Your personal data will be disclosed to third parties or otherwise communicated only, if you have granted your prior approval.

You are entitled to revoke the approval given at any time with effect for the future. 3. Your Right to obtain Information

4. Consent, Right of Revocation and Right of Objection
